



SESFC TERMS & CONDITIONS:

I hereby apply for Club Membership (Associate Club Membership for a parent of an U18 player) and agree to abide by and encourage all others to follow the FA Codes of Behaviour outlined on the Club's website www.sesfc.com

The Codes of Behaviour include but are not limited to:

- Displaying and promoting high standards of behaviour
- Respecting Officials decisions
- Not engaging in bullying, intimidation, or harassment
- Never engaging in offensive, insulting or abusive language or unsporting behaviour
- Reporting any instances of discrimination to a Committee member

Breaches of the Codes may result in warnings, fines, or suspensions.

Players or Parents of Players:

I acknowledge that online registration and payment of relevant fees does not guarantee membership. Membership is accepted if there is a space in a team for the player and granted when voted upon according to the Club Constitution at either the Club's Annual General Meeting or at a Management Committee Meeting.

Coaches, Managers & Volunteers:

I acknowledge that application for membership does not guarantee membership but will be voted upon according to the Club Constitution at either the Club's Annual General Meeting or at a Management Committee Meeting. I acknowledge that I will be required to hold a current QLD Government Working with Children Blue Card and must provide proof of same to the Club before I can volunteer. If I am ineligible to hold a Blue Card or fail to provide the Club with my Blue Card details, I understand I will not be able to volunteer.

Photographs on training and game days may be used on the Club website, Facebook and Instagram. I agree to notify the Club in writing each year if I do not wish for photographs of myself to be published. I agree not to hold the Club responsible for photographs taken by other members appearing on social media.

SESFC FEE PAYMENT:

Full fee payment is preferred at time of registration, however AfterPay and Instalment options will be available. Should an instalment payment fail for any reason, the associated players registration will be paused, meaning the player will not be eligible to participate in training nor games, until such time as the failed payment has been received along with an administration fee of \$11 paid to the club.

SESFC REFUND POLICY:

As per Football Queensland's Refund Policy, governing body fees are non-refundable once a player takes the park for a trial, training session or game.

SESFC may refund the Club/Referee component of a member's fully paid fees in accordance with the following schedule:

- De-register prior to 30 April – 60% of Club/Referee component will be refunded upon receipt of confirmation of de-registration being accepted by Football Queensland.
- De-register 1 May – 30 June – 30% of Club/Referee component will be refunded upon receipt of confirmation of de-registration being accepted by Football Queensland.
- De-register after 30 June will result in all fees being non-refundable.
