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# WHERE WE STARTED

St Joseph's Junior Soccer Club (SJSC) formed in 1971 at the present location of our junior base, Gordon Park, Marron Crescent, Mundingburra, wearing green shirts and brown shorts. The Club was known as St Joseph's and then Saints.

In 2005 Saints formed an affiliation with Eagles Souths United located at Aitkenvale Park, to provide a pathway for juniors into the senior competition. Eagles Souths was previously formed by the amalgamation of Townsville KS Polonia, a local Polish soccer club, with Souths United.

Saints Eagles Souths Football Club colours and logos are a combination of each of these clubs. Green and the Saints logo from SJSC, Red and the Eagle from Polonia and Black from Souths.



# OUR TEAMS

MiniRoos & Junior Competitive

Men's, Women's & Youth

In 2025 we fielded 34 MiniRoos teams and 4 Junior Competitive Teams. Our MiniRoos teams train weekly at our Marron Crescent Training Grounds in Mundingburra, whilst the majority of Junior Competitive teams train twice weekly. All teams play on Saturdays at Paradise Park from February through to September.

2025 saw us field 6 Men's teams including Youth, and 1 Women's team. In 2026 we're aiming for an additional team in both the men's and women's competitions participating in the FQN Northern Home and Away fixtures from March to September.

2025 teams will be decided upon once registrations are received

# FREQUENTLY ASKED Q&A

## WHEN DOES THE SEASON START?

Registrations are currently open for the 2026 season. Senior men's training has commenced in preparation for Kappa Queensland Cup matches for Premier Men at the beginning of February. MiniRoos, Junior and Senior Football competitions begin 19/20/21/22 March.

The 2026 season calendar can be found on our SESFC Parents & Players Facebook page.

Whilst MiniRoos & Junior teams play the majority of their matches at Paradise Park at the Murray Sports Complex, there is a requirement to travel to an outlying region such as Ayr, Charters Towers or Ingham at least once during the season to support the outlying regions participation in the Townsville competitions.

## WHAT DO FEES COVER?

Registration fees have 3 components. Governing body fees, Referee Fees for U12+ and Club fees. These fees do not include playing shorts or socks which can be purchased from both Aitkenvale Park & Marron Crescent clubhouses. The playing strip is supplied and remains the property of the club. In 2026 fees do include a training shirt.

## ARE FEES TO BE PAID BEFORE PLAYING?

Before participating in any preseason friendly/competition, fees must be paid in full OR by utilizing an Instalment Plan.

## WILL MY FEES BE REIMBURSED IF I DEREGISTER?

Governing body fees will not be reimbursed once you participate in either a training session or match. The Club's Refund Policy is contained in our Terms & Conditions available upon registering and are on our website. A portion of the Referee/Club component may be reimbursed after deducting fees for participation and an administrative fee.

# TRAINING SESSIONS



## MiniRoos U5 - U11

U5 to U11 teams generally train once per week between Monday to Thursday at our training grounds at Marron Crescent from 5pm - 6pm. The exception to this is Eagles of Excellence teams - training is twice a week until Easter, with the younger EoE teams dropping to just once a week thereafter.

## MiniRoos U12

Coaches may elect to train once or twice per week, but this is dependent upon coach and player availability. Training venues either at our Marron Crescent training grounds or on P2/P3 behind Aitkenvale Park, Petunia St, Aitkenvale.

## Junior Competitive U13 - U15

Junior competitive teams train twice weekly at P2/P3 behind Aitkenvale Park. Parking is available in the PCYC carpark off Wellington Street. Training days will be dependent upon coach and player availability.


## Youth & Senior Women

Youth Women's training will be dependent upon coach/player availability & TSP training. Senior Women will train on Tuesdays and Thursdays in 2026.

## Youth & Senior Men

Youth trials begin Monday January 12 & Wednesday January 14 at Aitkenvale Park. Senior Men train Tuesdays and Thursdays 6:30pm - 8:30pm at Aitkenvale Park.

# COACHING STARTS WITH THE DISCOVERY PHASE

The Discovery Phase is designed to:

- ▶ Facilitate the players discovery of football and the player actions required by providing a fun football environment
- ▶ There should be little to no 'coaching' however there is a need to organise fun football exercises
- ▶ Allow players to discover one's (im)possibilities through trial and error
- ▶ Natural development: players 'learn FOOTBALL by playing football'
- ▶ Replicate the 'street/park football' environment of the past
- ▶ Emphasis on building a love of the game whilst learning the four key pillars.

- ▶ Accredited Coaches & Managers receive free entry to Paradise Park for the season. Coaches need to undertake a FA Coaching Course in order to become accredited. MiniRoos - Free 2 - hour course.
